

Sound Exemption Application Guide

Construction sound exemptions

Construction Sound Exemption applications must be submitted to Permits, Licences and Inspections a minimum of five business days prior to the commencement of the sound in respect of which the exemption is sought. Application

Construction sound applications are now accepted online at tol.ca/buildingpermits. Submitting your application digitally is convenient and allows for a faster application process. If you require assistance with submitting your online application, please contact Permits, Licences and Inspections.

The applicant must submit:

- Construction Sound Exemption Application form including:
 - date and time of exemption
 - reasons for the exemption
 - measures to mitigate the sound for which the exemption is sought
- Construction Sound Notification Letter
- \$50.00 non-refundable fee

Sound exemption permit application process

Once the Manager, Permits and Inspections has reviewed the application, the applicant will be advised of the decision within two working days of submitting the application.

Prior to issuance

No sound from construction outside the permitted controls including hours as outlined in the [Community Standards Bylaw 2019 No. 5448](#) without obtaining a sound exemption permit from Permits and Inspections.

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
