

## What's next?

Public input from Phase 2 will be considered along with results from:

- Previous engagement (Phase 1 Engagement & Community Plan Process)
- Technical studies (i.e. environmental review and engineering assessments)

All of these results will feed directly into staff and consultant work to develop the draft neighbourhood plans, including the policy and urban design guidelines that will shape how the neighbourhood develops and how streets and buildings look and feel.

In Fall 2021, we will host another Open House, some online engagement, and a series of Policy Dialogue Sessions in order to present the draft neighbourhood plans and receive feedback.

Engagement events will be held either virtually or in-person depending on provincial public health orders related to the COVID-19.
